Dear sir,

In our unit, the foreign fellows are like the french fellows and they have a job as surgical assistant.

For this "job" in the unit and in the surgical room, legally you can not work more than 35 hours a week. You could be on call one time a week and one week-end a month. You don't have responsibilities.

You 'll, work with a surgeon of the team (7 surgeons), in accordance with the timetables. And after some weeks, we 'll help you for different surgeries.

How many hands ? We operate more than 2600 hands, 1700 carpal tunnel, 500 feet, and 600 shoulders per an.

The salary is 1200 euros/month, the meal are free and you are rent-free (you are in the center of the city in a nice flat). If you want, there is a scooter or you can use the bus.

Usually there is 2 foreigners fellows and a french fellow. The fellowship duration is 6 months, like the visa.

Now, we must obtain your visa to the french embassy. You'll have a special status of associate student (like «course participant»).

For that, we need your CV, a passport copy, and a recommendation letter of your head of department. After, we 'll give these files at our administrative offices in France to study the documents and after you could obtain the visa for 6 months.
